

Wild Fires

You can help defend your property from wildfire damage with a little bit of work over the weekend.

Remove

- · Dry grass and dead leaves AT LEAST 30 FEET from home
- · Branches within 10 feet of chimneys

Prune

· Lower branches within six feet of the ground

Cover

 Chimneys, attic and sub-floor vents with a non-combustible screening of 1/4 inch or smaller mesh

Plant

- · Native, fire-resistant vegetation
- All trees and shrubs at least 10 feet apart

Maintain

· A legible and clearly marked street number

Install

· Roof covering material with a Class A fire-resistive rating

Maintain an emergency water supply within 1,000 feet of your home through one of the following:

- · Community water/hydrant system
- · Drafting site on a lake
- Cooperative emergency storage tank with neighbors
- Swimming pool



Remember, if under a wildfire threat, only remove dead leaves or vegetation when local garbage collection services will have time to pick up the debris.
